Major Enforcement Effort Seeks to Save Lives

Sobriety and Driver's License Checkpoint

Drunk Driving is one of America's deadliest crimes. In 2005, nationally nearly 16,000 and last year statewide nearly 1,600 people died in crashes involving a driver or motorcycle operator.

That is why San José Police Department Traffic Enforcement Unit announced today they will be conducting a Sobriety and Driver's License Checkpoint along with other law enforcement and highway safety agencies across the state and nation during this Thanksgiving celebration.

On Saturday, November 24, 2007, officers from the San José Police Department's Traffic Enforcement Unit will set up a Sobriety and Driver's License Checkpoint on Blossom Hill Rd. at Snell Ave. in San Jose. This checkpoint will operate between 9:30PM and 3:30AM.
