### DETAILS:

On January 11, 2008, at approximately 5:05 PM, San Jose Police Canine Officer John Ceballos was meeting with the property owner of a vacant commercial building located on the 500 block of Trimble Road. Officer Ceballos and the property owner were discussing the possibility to use the building for training police dogs in building searches.

While walking through the building, Officer Ceballos and the property owner walked towards an electrical room and were startled to find a man standing in the room stripping copper wire from the walls. Next to the electrical room was a stack of already cut copper wire from the building.

Upon further investigation, the suspect was arrested and booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for Burglary and Possession of Burglary Tools.
